

Winchcombe School – Catch-Up Funding 2017-2018

Winchcombe School receives 'Catch-Up' Funding to enable Y7 students to make further progress in Literacy and Numeracy, from their Primary School Y6 end of Key Stage 2 levels.

As a school, we are determined to boost students' levels of attainment as rapidly as possible, throughout Y7 and beyond.

The Funding spend includes:

- Literacy and Numeracy Coordinators who facilitate, monitor and teach students in Y7, across a range of Intervention strategies
- 'Reading Wise' – a Literacy Intervention which increases Reading Age, over time.
- ARROW – staff training, equipment, and implementation
- 'Spinner' Books – a range of resources for students with low Reading Ages
- 'Fresh Start' Module-based Texts to boost Literacy levels
- IXL Maths – Web-based Numeracy interventions to focus on basic Mathematical techniques and topics

Other Interventions include:

- Identified Y7 Students who use some MFL/French periods to boost both English and Maths basic skills
- Reading Buddies in older year groups (Y8/Y9) who work with Y7 Students, on a weekly basis, to build confidence and understanding
